Hon'ble Rabbi Uri Cherki - a special Succoth festival message to the Noahide world:

Shalom and Happy Succoth festival Greetings to all our Noahide world. Succoth is entirely a different festival than all other Jewish festivals comparatively. Succoth festival is very close to the Nature. Four types of species (Araba Minim) are gathered together and shaken and the Succah is constructed with green plant leaves, drawing of the water for water libation of alter with all these festival celebrations the Jewish Nefesh will be mingled with nature. In contrast, many Jew's fear and feel that all these are unhabitable things and leads to idolatry. If we observe Jewish festivals i.e., in the Pesach leavened food is not eaten, in the Shavuoth not sleeping, in the Rosh Hashanah fearing of Hashem and in the Yom Kippur entirely fasting etc. But at last, in the Succoth festival having a joyous chance to spend in the nature. The reason why, during the Rosh Hashanah to Yom Kippur we repent from all our sins and come out from all our evil inclinations. Hence, we enter purely with our simple and natural behavior, uniting with the nature during Succoth. And it will not made us to fall in evil or bad things and help us to have a better and a high place. Also, during the Succoth, we are having a 'Holiness of Nature'.

"Hon'ble Rabbi Kook, of blessed memory said, nature's holiness belongs to the people of the world and beyond or above the nature's holiness belongs to the Jewish people".

Therefore, these two Holinesses unite and connect each other to bring the 'Fullest Holiness' during Succoth. Henceforth, prophet Zechariah prophesized that during the festival of Succoth, people of all the gentile nations will come to the Jerusalem Temple to worship Hashem. Henceforth, 70 cows were used to sacrifice to atone 70 nations during Temple times.
